## The Program:

The Academy summer program provides students with a fun, educational option for the summer. We strive to create a perfect balance between tutorial, small group instruction and experiential outdoor education. This approach allows students to remain engaged in learning throughout the summer and apply academic and social skills to learning experiences outside the classroom.

## Course Descriptions:

### Social pragmatic skills:

Taught through a variety of games, challenges, and cooperative initiatives both in and out of the academic setting.

### Content area skill-building:

Direct systematic instruction based on individual goals and objectives. Students work within small groups or individually in the areas of language, math, and reading.

### Classroom without walls:

Interactive hands-on instruction: students gain practice in problem solving, interpreting information, comprehension, verbal communications, and cooperative learning. Such learning expeditions and adventure experiences as hiking, biking, and boating give students the opportunity to learn outside the classroom.



### Individualized program:

The Academy has the ability to create individually tailored programs in many subjects for students who need makeup credits, further refinement, or are seeking enrichment.

### Reading tutorial:

Direct instruction in comprehension, fluency, and phonemic awareness. A variety of programs are available: Wilson Reading, Orton Gillingham and LindaMood Bell.

### Writing tutorial:

Direct instruction in effective written expression based on students' current level of performance.

### Math tutorial:

Direct instruction based on students' current level of performance. Math options range from basic math skills, algebra, geometry and vocational math.
